<b>Langham Hotel</b>	The Hotel is 20km (12.5 miles) from Melbourne's International Airport. The journey takes approximately 30 minutes by car. The hotel is 500 metres from the City and approximately 5 minutes walk from Flinders Street Station. The Langham is situated near the Victorian Arts Centre, Melbourne Concert Hall, Royal Botanic Gardens & Federation Square.
<b>Taxi</b>	Transfer by taxi from Melbourne Airport to the city centre takes approximately 30 minutes and costs approximately \$50.00.
<b>Sky Bus</b>	The airport shuttle operates daily at regular intervals between the airport and hotels in the city. Airport pick up is at ground floor level outside the International Terminal. The bus departs every ½ hour and the travel time to the Langham is approximately 30 minutes. Approximate cost one-way \$20.00, return \$35.00 (open ticket). <b>City Circle Tram</b>	The free City Circle Tram runs in both directions around the city centre perimeter. Hours of operation: 10.00 – 18:00 seven days a week, at 10-minute intervals. The circuit takes 30 minutes, going to many city attractions. A running commentary is provided and attendants on board will answer any questions.
<b>Climate</b>	Melbourne has four distinct seasons. Temperatures range from 10 to 25 C during spring.
