Coursework or research?

Whether you decide to enrol in a coursework program, a research program or a program featuring both modes of study, largely depends on what you want to achieve and your study preferences.

Postgraduate degrees are for students who already have an undergraduate degree and want to study further. Some postgraduate degrees may accept work experience instead of a bachelors degree as a basis for entry. Other postgraduate degrees require both. Awards include: graduate certificates, graduate diplomas, postgraduate diplomas and masters.

Coursework

A coursework program involves a structured program of compulsory and elective units. Coursework programs include: graduate certificates, graduate diplomas, postgraduate diplomas and masters degrees by coursework.

You should study a coursework program to extend your knowledge and understanding of an area and acquire skills to improve your career prospects. Coursework degrees include no more than 33 per cent research.

Research

Higher degrees by research are special postgraduate courses focused on an original research project. Entry usually requires an honours year of study or an equivalent postgraduate qualification.

Research degrees include a research component of at least 66 per cent and can be up to 100 per cent research-based.

Research study gives you the opportunity to explore questions that you find stimulating. With the guidance of your supervisor, you determine the topic and the structure of your program. Research degrees include masters by research, Master of Philosophy, professional doctorate, or Doctor of Philosophy (PhD).

You should study a research program to gain a deeper understanding of your chosen field of study; focus on specific issues and expand your current knowledge. Some research programs may combine research with professional experience and coursework.

Understanding postgraduate awards

Graduate certificate

A graduate certificate can be the first half of a graduate diploma or an academic award in its own right. Graduate certificates can be completed in six months of full-time study.

Graduate diploma

A graduate diploma is a one year, subject-based program, providing the equivalent of an undergraduate major. You can take a graduate diploma to add a new qualification (such as teaching), to the one you have already studied to enhance career options or as preparation for further graduate study (normally by coursework).

Postgraduate diploma

With a postgraduate diploma, you can complete a one-year program to build upon studies you have completed at bachelor degree level. Students generally take on a postgraduate diploma to enhance career options, or as preparation for further graduate study by coursework or research.

Masters preliminary/qualifying year

A masters preliminary or qualifying year amounts to a year of coursework or a program that has coursework and research combined. The program is designed to prepare you for masters level studies by either coursework or research.

Masters degree by coursework

A masters degree by coursework is a subject based program at the higher degree level. Some programs offer a research component. Students who undertake a masters degree by coursework are usually seeking to extend their knowledge and skills and enhance their career options.

Research degrees

Research students enrolled in a masters or doctorate by 100 per cent research do not attend classes, but are required to attend campus on a regular basis to undertake an independent research project under the guidance of an experienced academic supervisor. Research students will also be required to attend regular departmental seminars and present their research at appropriate forums, locally, nationally and internationally.

Masters degree by research

A masters degree by research is a program that enables you to undertake substantial and independent research under expert academic supervision. Some masters degrees by research include a coursework component of up to 33 per cent. Students usually undertake a masters degree by research with the aim of enhancing their research skills and techniques or as preparation for doctoral studies. If eligible, you may upgrade from masters to doctoral level studies in your first year of study.

Master of Philosophy

The Master of Philosophy (MPhil) was introduced to complement existing faculty-based research masters programs. It is administered by the Monash Research Graduate School. A MPhil thesis is expected to make a contribution to an existing body of knowledge by applying, clarifying, critiquing or interpreting that knowledge.

The MPhil is an 18 months full-time equivalent program. The degree is normally a 100 per cent research program. However, some faculties may include a coursework component, not exceeding 33 per cent of the program.

Professional doctorate

A professional doctorate normally combines independent research under expert academic supervision and subject-based study. Such a doctorate is designed to improve professional practice by extending your knowledge, expertise and skills through the application of research to contemporary issues. Usually a professional doctorate takes three to four years of full-time study to complete.

Doctor of Philosophy (PhD)

Traditionally, a PhD has been a research only program, normally completed in three to four years of full-time study. Today, some PhD programs offer a limited component of coursework. The PhD program enables students to undertake substantial, original research, which is conducted under expert academic supervision and declared to be a significant contribution to knowledge.

External candidature

External candidature is available for a number of research degrees, where you pursue independent, sustained and structured research off-campus.

As an external PhD student, you must be able to discuss your progress at least once every two weeks with your Monash-based supervisor and undertake the equivalent of 15 days on-campus attendance per year at a Monash campus. An annual on-campus attendance of 10 days is required for external MPhil students. Faculties will advise whether external candidature is available for masters by research degrees.

Students studying through external candidature mode do not qualify for an Australian student visa.

Off-campus learning

Off-campus learning is a flexible mode of study. Most commonly it is based on a combination of independent learning materials and learning support systems, with attendance at a teaching site either not required or kept to a minimum. However, for a small number of courses there are compulsory attendance requirements, primarily for those that are laboratory-based or require group interaction.

Off-campus learning material in the form of study guides will be made available to all students. Prescribed textbooks will be available from the university bookshop or as advised by the lecturer. Students will require access to a computer with email and internet access, either at home or via commercial access points or facilities at local libraries.

International students also need to keep in mind their student visa application. This may take up to six months or more, depending on their nationality and country of residence.

English entry requirements

Category A – University requirements for postgraduate coursework degrees

The minimum English entry requirements of the University for applicants commencing study in postgraduate coursework degrees in 2010 are a guide only, as many courses and faculties have higher requirements. You must consult faculty websites for the specific requirements of the course that you are applying for.

Applicants to postgraduate coursework courses whose secondary schooling **was entirely in English** may fulfil the English language entry requirements by one of the following:

1. Satisfactorily completing a sufficient period of study, at a sufficiently advanced level, in an English-medium institution. The applicant must have satisfactorily completed either:
 - An undergraduate degree, or
 - The equivalent of at least 72 Monash University credit points (three standard full-time semesters) of a university degree or Australian TAFE diploma, or equivalent, or
 - The equivalent of at least 48 Monash credit points (one full-time year) of postgraduate study.
2. Satisfactorily completing a Monash University faculty certificate, faculty diploma, executive certificate or executive diploma comprising at least 24 credit points of postgraduate-level units.

Applicants to postgraduate coursework courses whose secondary schooling was **not entirely in English** may fulfil the English language entry requirements by one of the following:

1. Satisfactorily completing a sufficient period of study, at a sufficiently advanced level, in an English-medium institution. The applicant must have satisfactorily completed either:
 - An undergraduate degree within the five years prior to commencement of the course of intended enrolment, or
 - The equivalent of at least 72 Monash University credit points (three standard full-time semesters) of a university degree or Australian TAFE diploma, or equivalent, within the two years prior to commencement of the course for which the application was made, or
 - The equivalent of at least 48 Monash credit points (one full-time year) of postgraduate study within the two years prior to commencement of the course for which application was made.
2. Gaining the required result in one of the following tests of English language:
 - A minimum overall IELTS test score of at least 6.5 with individual band scores of at least 6.5 for Reading, 6.5 for Listening, 6.0 for Writing and 6.0 for Speaking.

- A TOEFL minimum test score of either:
 - in the written TOEFL, 580 with a Test of Written English (TWE) score of at least 4.5
 - in the internet-based TOEFL, an overall score of at least 90 with at least 22 in the written section and no less than 20 in any section.
- 3. Successful completion of the English Language Bridging Program, at the appropriate level, in the Monash University English Language Centre or another program approved as equivalent.

Category B – higher requirements for postgraduate coursework degrees

The **Faculty of Business and Economics** requires a minimum IELTS score of 7.0 with no individual band score less than 6.5; or a TOEFL minimum test score of 600 with a TWE score of at least 5; or an internet-based score of 100 overall with at least 24 in Writing and no section lower than 20.

Postgraduate courses offered by the **Faculty of Education** that include a practicum component require at least three years of study in a university or approved tertiary institution where English is the language of instruction and assessment of the entire institution; or an IELTS (academic) score of at least 7.0 with a score of at least 7.0 in Speaking and Writing and at least 6.5 in Reading and Listening; or a TOEFL internet-based score of 100

overall, with at least 25 in Writing and Speaking and 22 in Reading and Listening.

In the **Faculty of Medicine, Nursing and Health Sciences** there are higher English language requirements for the courses offered in the Department of Epidemiology and Preventive Medicine and some of the courses in the Department of Medical Imaging and Radiation Sciences. In the **Faculty of Law** masters of eight units and graduate diplomas of eight units require an overall IELTS band score of at least 7.0 with no individual band score of less than 6.5; or a TOEFL minimum test score of 600 with a TWE score of at least 4.5; or an internet-based TOEFL of 100 overall with at least 24 in Writing and no section lower than 20.

In the **Faculty of Law**, the Juris Doctor requires an IELTS score of at least 7.0 in each individual band; or a total TOEFL score of at least 600 with a TWE of 5.0; or an internet based score of 102 with a writing score of 24 and no other section lower than 20.

In the **Faculty of Arts** there are also higher English language requirements for the Master of Interpreting and Translation Studies and the Graduate Diploma in Translation Studies.

Category C – University requirements for postgraduate research degrees

The Research Graduate School Committee sets the English proficiency requirements for all higher degrees by research. One of the following must be met:

- First language is English
- An overall score of not less than 6.5 on the IELTS test conducted by IDP and the British Council. In addition, a score of at least 6.0 is required for each band score and applicants must undertake the academic module in regard to reading and writing. Tests that are taken more than two years prior to application will not be accepted. Details can be found at www.ielts.org.
- The following scores achieved in the American Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL):
 - a minimum total score of 577 together with a score of 5 or more on the TOEFL Test of Written English (TWE) (paper based score); or
 - a minimum total score of 233 together with a score of 5 or more on the TOEFL Essay Rating (ER) (computer-based score); or
 - a minimum total score of 91 (internet-based score) together with a minimum score of 25 in the written test and a minimum score of 22 in each of the reading, speaking and listening tests.

Tests that are taken more than two years prior to application will not be accepted. Details can be found at www.toefl.org.

- Successful completion of a course of tertiary studies of at least two-years duration conducted entirely in English and involving formal assessment of written work, in a country where English is the official language. Evidence in the form of a letter or certificate issued by the university registrar's office will need to be provided. Studies must be completed within the five-year period prior to application. In the faculties of **Arts and Law**, studies must be completed within the two year period prior to application. Where studies have been conducted entirely in English and involving formal assessment of written work in a country where English is one of two or more official languages of that country, a case may

be made to the Monash Research Graduate School Committee by the relevant department/faculty. The World Factbook located at www.cia.gov/cia/publications/factbook lists the official languages of all countries.

- Successful completion of a course of tertiary studies of at least two-years duration at Monash's Malaysia or South Africa campus, or an equivalent Malaysian tertiary education campus recognised by Monash University. Studies must be completed within the five-year period prior to application. In the **Faculty of Arts and Faculty of Law**, studies must be completed within the two-year period prior to application.
- An overall IELTS score of 6.0 (writing score of 6.0); or a paper-based TOEFL score of 550 with a TWE of 4.5 or internet-based TOEFL score of 79 with a minimum score of 22 in the written test and a minimum score of 19 in the listening, reading and speaking tests, together with successful completion of the 10-week Monash University English Language Bridging Program (ELBP). Applicants will not be admitted to candidature until they have successfully completed the ELBP. Some faculties, for example the **Faculty of Arts and Faculty of Law**, do not admit candidates under this criterion. Scholarship applicants must have evidence of successful completion of the 10-week ELBP by the closing date for scholarships to be eligible.

Category D – higher requirements for postgraduate research degrees

In the **Faculty of Arts**, an overall score of 7.0 on the IELTS test (7.0 on writing module) and a minimum TOEFL total score of 600 and a score of 5.0 or more in the TWE (paper based) or a minimum total score of 100 with a minimum score of 25 in each of the written, reading, speaking and listening tests (internet-based test).

In the **Faculty of Law**, an overall score of 7.0 on the IELTS test (7.0 on writing module) and a minimum TOEFL total score of 600 and a score of 5.0 or more in the TWE (paper based) or a minimum total score of 100 with a minimum score of 25 in each of the written, reading, speaking and listening tests (internet-based test).

In the **Department of Epidemiology and Preventive Medicine** and in the **Faculty of Business and Economics**, an overall IELTS score of 7.0 with individual band scores of 6.5.

In the **Faculty of Education** an IELTS (academic) minimum score of at least 7.0 on the IELTS test (with at least 7.0 in Writing and at least 6.5 for remaining scores) or; a TOEFL score of at least 600 with a TWE score of at least 5.0; internet-based 100 overall, with at least 25 in Writing and 22 for remaining scores.

Note: Full documentary evidence in support of English proficiency must be submitted with applications for candidature. Where an applicant's first language is not English or where degree qualifications were not undertaken in the English language, Monash reserves the right to seek further documentary evidence of English proficiency.

If you have not yet satisfied any of the above English language requirements, the most effective pathway is to undertake an English course at the Monash University English Language Centre.

The Centre is one of Australia's largest and most prestigious language centres. It offers an English Language Bridging Program that bridges the gap between students' previous English language qualifications and those accepted by Monash. The program will help students focus on academic conventions, expectations and strategies of university study in a supportive and collaborative environment.

Note: The English language requirements outlined above are minimum requirements for admission to a research degree. Recent changes to visa regulations require applicants from assessment level countries 3 and 4 to provide a satisfactory IELTS test score when applying for a student visa.

Domestic students

Full-fee places

Most postgraduate coursework programs are offered as full-fee places. Students in these courses pay the full tuition cost of the course and must make the payment upfront each semester.

Details of course fees for Australian citizens and permanent residents are included with course descriptions in this guide. **Fees quoted are subject to change and are indicative only. Applicants should check the fee with faculties or go to Monash University course finder: www.monash.edu/study**

Monash University reserves the right to adjust annual tuition fees. However the University undertakes that any adjustment factor for those continuing students will not exceed 6 per cent per annum. Any adjustment will be applied on January 1 each year for that year.

Domestic research students

Most Australian or permanent resident research students at Monash University are granted a government-funded Research Training Scheme (RTS) place. Under this scheme, research students receive two full-time equivalent years of funding for a research masters course and four years of full-time equivalent funding for doctoral studies.

In 2008 Monash received \$42 million from the Commonwealth government to support research training for students undertaking doctorate and masters degree by research programs.

If an RTS place is not available, students may be given a non-Commonwealth-funded place where the course fees are covered until an RTS place becomes available.

Under the RTS, it is a statutory requirement that all higher degree by research students provide details of previous enrolments in research programs to determine eligibility for RTS funding.

Higher Education Loan Program (HELP)

A suite of loans has been introduced under the Higher Education Loan Program (HELP). The FEE-HELP scheme provides an interest-free, income-contingent loan facility for eligible students enrolled in:

- Accredited award programs including higher degrees by research
- Bridging courses for overseas-trained professionals to enable them to meet the requirements for entry into their profession in Australia;
- Eligible courses that enable students to meet the requirements for entry into an award program.

Australian citizens and holders of a permanent humanitarian visa are eligible for the FEE-HELP scheme. New Zealand citizens and holders of other permanent visas do not have access to HELP loans and must pay their tuition fees upfront without a discount.

Eligible students wishing to pay part or all of their tuition fees through FEE-HELP must complete the loan request form by the relevant census date and provide a tax file number. A student can elect to pay a portion of fees directly to the University and the remaining debt will be registered as a loan through the Australian Taxation Office (ATO).

Student contribution amounts

For Commonwealth supported places (CSPs), units are grouped into four broad bands. The band in which the unit is located determines the student contribution amount for that unit. Usually, the units a student is required to enrol in to complete their course will each fall into the same band. The following table outlines the annual student contribution amount for a full-time student who is enrolled in a standard full-time course where all units are in the same band. Students typically undertake 8 units each year. Units are normally 6 credit points each. In a standard full-time year, students will study 48 credit points.

Students will commence repaying any HELP loan through the ATO once their income reaches the minimum threshold for compulsory repayment. A loan for up to the full tuition fee charged for the course can be accessed, but there is a lifetime limit of \$83,313 and a limit of \$104,142 for medicine, from 1 January 2009.

Commonwealth-supported places (CSP)

Australian Government legislation requires higher education students in a Commonwealth supported place to contribute to the cost of their education. This means that students pay a proportion of the cost of their course and the government funds the balance. Please see the table above for further information.

Some postgraduate places at Monash University are CSP. In previous years, this type of place was known as a HECS place (Higher Education Contribution Scheme). For further information on CSP and student contribution amounts, visit: www.goingtouni.gov.au.

Credit points and fees

The University uses a standard credit point range in relation to university taught unit offerings, normally involving 6 point units or multiples thereof (eg 6, 12, 18, 24). A full-time student will normally complete 48 credit points in a year (24 in each semester).

Fees published in this guide quote an annual fee based on a standard 48 credit point course. Courses with fewer or more credit point values in a year will attract a proportionate fee. For example a 24 credit point course fee will be half the annual amount of a 48 credit point course. A 72 credit point course would be one and a half times the published annual fee.

International students

Tuition fees

To study at Monash University international students must pay tuition fees to the University. Tuition fees vary depending on the course. Further information is available at www.monash.edu/study. International students should also consult the *2010 International Postgraduate Application Guide* which lists tuition fees for international students.

Overseas Student Health Cover fees

It is an Australian Government visa regulation for international students studying on a student visa to have compulsory Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) for the duration of their stay in Australia.

Monash University requires all commencing international students to purchase visa length cover at the time of accepting their offer; that is, health cover that will last for the duration of your visa. The electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE) for student visa application will not be issued until:

- The OSHC payment has been received (along with payment of fee deposit); or
- Proof has been submitted that visa length OSHC has been purchased with an approved Australian OSHC provider of your choice; or
- Approved documentation has been submitted for exemption from payment of OSHC.

If you and one or more siblings are enrolled in a Monash University full-fee course at the same time, you may be entitled to a 10 per cent discount on your annual tuition fees.

Advance course fee payment

Students who pay course fees for the duration of their course at the time of accepting their offer will be eligible for a discount. This is available to commencing students who meet the following criteria:

- Full-time international or domestic students in multi-year courses with Monash University
- Students who pay their full course fee up-front, in advance
- Normal course progression is maintained
- Also available for eligible international students applying to Monash through a Monash education agent

Students who pay the course fees for the duration of their course will not be subject to annual fee increments. Please note that the final discount amount varies according to the course taken.

Research scholarships

Awards may be held for a research masters for up to two years, and for a PhD or professional doctorate degree for up to three years with a possible six-month extension.

Applicants for centrally allocated awards must hold an Australian or New Zealand bachelors degree with first class honours or qualifications and/or research experience deemed equivalent by the University. There are no age restrictions.

Living allowance (stipend) scholarships and awards available include the Australian Postgraduate Awards (APA), the Australian Postgraduate Awards (Industry), the Monash Graduate Scholarships (MGS), the Monash Silver Jubilee Postgraduate Scholarship, and the Sir James McNeill Foundation Postgraduate Scholarship.

The Monash Research Graduate School offers generous travel grants for conference attendance and other activities related to the candidate's research project. Doctoral and masters by research students who are under examination may also apply for publication grants. A statistical support service is also available.

Research scholarships

There are various scholarships for international students wishing to undertake a masters degree by research or doctoral program at Monash University. Applicants should hold or expect to hold a bachelor degree with first class honours or qualifications and/or research experience deemed equivalent by the University. There are no age restrictions.

Some scholarships cover living expenses and may be combined with a second scholarship covering tuition fees. Living allowance scholarships include, Monash Graduate Scholarships, Silver Jubilee Postgraduate Scholarship and the Sir James McNeill Foundation Postgraduate Scholarship.

Tuition fee scholarships include the Endeavour International Postgraduate Research Scholarships, the International Monash Postgraduate Research Scholarships and the Vera Moore International Postgraduate Research Scholarship.

The Monash Research Graduate School offers generous travel grants for conference attendance and other activities related to the candidate's research project. Doctoral and masters by research students who are under examination may also apply for publication grants. A statistical support service is also available.

Coursework scholarships

Monash offers a range of merit scholarships to international students based on their academic achievement in their previous studies. New international students are automatically assessed for eligibility for these scholarships when they submit their application for admission through International Recruitment Services.

Financial assistance

Financial assistance is provided through student advisers based at all campuses. Student advisers are available to assist students with a variety of financial matters such as student loans, Youth Allowance, Austudy, and budgeting.

Youth Allowance/Austudy

(Only available to Australian citizens and permanent residents).

These payments are the major form of Commonwealth Government financial assistance to full-time postgraduate diploma students and are means-tested. Payment of a fortnightly allowance varies according to a student's age and circumstances and is subject to a personal income test.

There are different categories of Austudy and Youth Allowance (independent, dependent, special). Further information is available from Centrelink and the Health, Wellbeing and Development office.

Student loans

Emergency short-term and long-term loans are available to all Monash students who are experiencing unexpected and acute financial difficulty. Long-term loans are also available to students to assist with study-related costs such as books, computers and bond or rent-in-advance. All students are encouraged to discuss their financial difficulties with a student adviser before applying for student loans.

Programs in detail and how to apply

Research programs

PhD programs

PhD programs may be undertaken in each of the University's faculties and the Monash University Accident Research Centre. A PhD program should take no more than four years of full-time study to complete.

A PhD candidate normally will have qualified for a research masters degree, or a bachelors degree at H1 or H2A level or equivalent. Candidates must demonstrate that they will be able to meet the necessary attendance and residency requirements. External PhD candidature is also available. External candidates must have access to email or videoconferencing facilities. A period of annual on-campus attendance is mandatory. Note that there are other postgraduate research programs where the research component may be undertaken by external mode. These include the SJD (professional doctorate in juridical science) and the Master of Philosophy.

The PhD has been expanded to include performance, exhibition and portfolio-based programs. These are offered in the specialties of visual arts, music composition and creative writing.

PhD programs with a coursework component and professional doctorates

The Department of Economics and the Centre for Comparative Literature and Cultural Studies currently provide coursework components to PhD programs. The PhD in the specialty of visual arts also includes coursework in addition to an exhibition and thesis (exegesis component). The Faculty of Law SJD program also includes a coursework component. It is possible that other academic units may offer a program with a coursework component in the future.

The professional doctorate offered in psychology, public health and juridical science is a program that normally combines coursework and research dissertation components. It is designed to improve professional practice by extending the knowledge, expertise and skill of students through the application of research to current problems and issues.

Doctor of Medicine

Doctor of Medicine (MD) programs in The Faculty of Medicine, Nursing and Health Sciences offers two MD programs, one with and one without supervision. The MD with supervision is governed by regulations similar to those for the PhD program. The MD without supervision, however, is governed by regulations similar to those for higher doctorates, and applications for this degree should be made according to the instructions on the MRGS website: www.mrgs.monash.edu/research

Masters by research

Entry requirements vary from program to program, and applicants should check the entry requirements detailed under the various programs for more information.

Research application procedures for domestic and international students

Applications for admission to a research degree may be made at any time however applications for research scholarships must be submitted by 31 October each year.

Local and international prospective students apply for entry into a research degree online using the online application form at, www.monash.edu/study/research

Research degree applicants are required to submit a research proposal as part of their application so it is important that prospective candidates identify possible research projects and topics that align with their interests, qualifications and experience. Prospective candidates are encouraged to seek further information about the research expertise of academic staff through the websites and brochures of research centres, faculties, schools and departments.

Coursework programs

Masters by coursework

A masters degree by coursework is a subject-based program. Masters degrees generally take one to two years to complete on a full-time basis (up to four years part-time). Entry requirements vary from program to program, and applicants should check the entry requirements detailed under the various programs for more information.

Postgraduate and graduate diplomas

Postgraduate and graduate diploma courses are subject based and are usually studied over one year on a full-time basis (two years part-time). Entry requirements vary from program to program, and applicants should check the entry requirements given under the various programs for more specific details.

Graduate certificates

Graduate certificate courses are undertaken by coursework and usually require one semester of full-time study (one year part-time). Entry requirements vary from program to program, and applicants should check the entry requirements given under the various programs for more specific details. Graduate certificates are generally not available for direct admission to international students due to visa restrictions. Some graduate certificates are available to international applicants outside Australia who study via off-campus learning (study at home).
