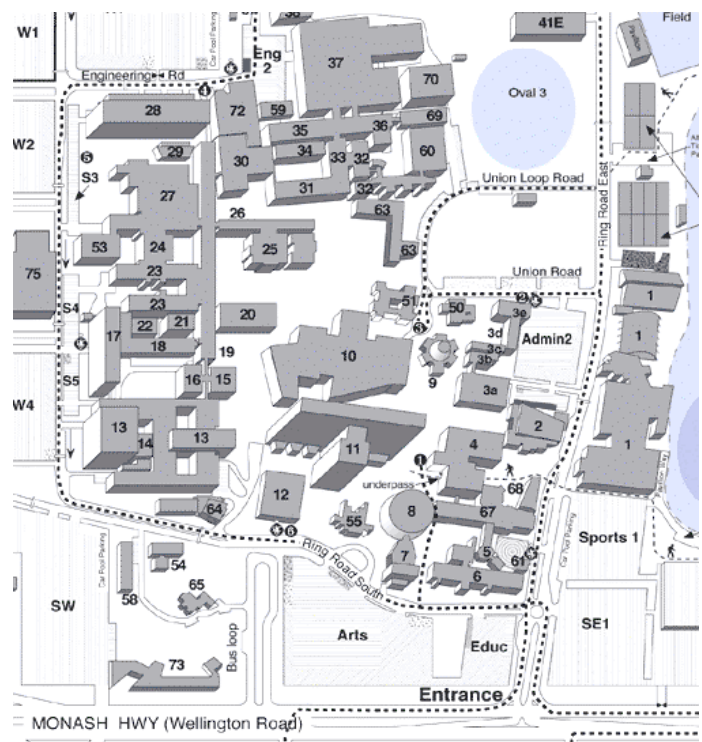
REHABTech Services Update
