

Admissions table and entry requirements

The Admissions Table is a quick reference guide to the entry requirements for all Monash undergraduate courses.

Fees

To study at Monash University you must pay tuition fees to the University. Tuition fees vary for different courses. Tuition fees are detailed in the Admissions Table of this guide and at: www.monash.edu/study/international/courses/fees.html.

Health-care fees

It is an Australian Government visa regulation for international students studying on a student visa to have compulsory Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) for the duration of their stay in Australia.

Monash University requires all commencing international students to purchase visa length health-cover at the time of accepting their offer; that is, health cover that will last for the duration of their visa.

The electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE) for student visa application will not be issued until:

- The OSHC payment has been received (along with payment of tuition fee deposit), or;
- Proof has been submitted that visa length OSHC has been purchased with an approved Australian healthcare provider of your choice, or;
- Approved documentation has been submitted for exemption from payment of OSHC.

English language requirements

All Monash applicants must satisfy the minimum English language requirements of the University.

International students undertaking Year 12 in Australia must complete and achieve a satisfactory level of performance in an English subject at Year 12 or equivalent level. For VCE students, this means a minimum study score of at least 25 in units 3 and 4 in any VCE English subject. Students undertaking English as a Second Language (ESL) are required to achieve a minimum study score of 30. International students undertaking the IB Diploma should receive a score of at least 4 in English. Some courses may require a higher English study score.

Students who receive an ESL score of between 25 and 29 are advised to contact Monash University to discuss their study options as they may be eligible for the 15-week English Language Bridging Program for select courses.
