Presentations can cover the same topics as a campus visit and can be tailored to include specific faculty or transition information.

Enhancement Studies

The Enhancement Studies Program provides an opportunity for high-achieving students to study a Monash first-year-level subject (as a unit pair) in lieu of a sixth VCE subject. Students complete their Enhancement study in one of three ways: by attending classes at selected secondary schools; by studying via distance education using study material packages; or by a combination of studying via distance education and attending regular tutorials held at selected schools.

A broad range of subjects is available predominantly in the areas of Arts, Business and Economics, Information Technology and Science. Handbooks will be delivered to schools in Term 3. The Enhancement Studies Program is endorsed by the Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority

Application deadline for all other Enhancement subjects: 28 November 2008.
